- **Nursing Station** positioned to support efficient care and patient monitoring.
- **Welcome Desk** for a welcoming and easy-to-navigate entrance experience.
- **Patient Room** designed to support healing, privacy, and family presence.
- **Med/Surg Waiting Room** supporting families during procedures and recovery.
- **Main Waiting Area** designed to be a comfortable space for patients and families.
- **Main Hallway** with wide walkways designed for safety and efficiency.



# Built for Our Community's Future

Construction on the new hospital began in 2025 and continues to move forward with exciting progress. Foundations are complete, structural steel is rising, and the vision for the future is taking shape. The new McKenzie hospital is projected to open in Q1 2027, continuing a tradition of exceptional healthcare close to home.
