These scopes help doctors diagnose and treat problems such as GERD (Gastroesophageal Reflux Disease) and colon cancer.

When it comes to the care of our families and friends, imagine what we can do together!

What is it for? The tower and monitor are required to perform colonoscopy (lower GI) and EGD (upper GI) procedures. Instruments used connect to the tower and monitor.

Why do we need this? The current tower we have is from 2009 and will not support newer scopes. The new tower will provide a higher definition view for the Gastroenterologist and is adaptable for newer scopes as they become available.

Will our scopes work with a new tower? Yes

Is this equipment needed often? These procedures are performed more than any other procedure in our surgical department. They are valuable for monitoring people for potential gastrointestinal disease that can be found before it becomes a problem.
